- No mental, verbal, or physical abuse of any person will be tolerated. All persons at camp are expected to adhere to the Cub Scout Promise and Law of the Pack at all times.
- I am aware of camp dates and hours: Tigers, Wolves, Bears and Webelos attend camp Monday through Friday 7:45 am -1:30 pm. The parent/guardian agrees to provide or arrange for transportation to and from Cub World.
